To further support your student in making appropriate decisions about their future pathways we have scheduled a meeting on **Monday 31<sup>st</sup> July** to discuss your student's subject selections for Year 11 2024.

Our aim is to work collaboratively with you in providing relevant career and transition guidance for your student.

Mr Blinman, the Future Pathways Adviser, will be available to provide information and advice about TAFE options and tertiary education. Mrs. Watts, Deputy Principal, will also be available to answer specific questions regarding course requirements for HSC and ATAR.

Students will have received their Semester One Reports prior to this date. This is to allow time for parents/guardians to review the report in conjunction with their child prior to the meeting.

Prior to the meeting, students must complete the Personalised Learning Plan (students receive week 1 term 3). Please bring the following to the meeting:

□ Semester One Report

□ the completed Personalised Learning Plan

Students will be required to nominate their preferred courses using a WebChoice system online. Further instructions and passwords for the WebChoice system will be provided to students through a meeting and via email on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> July, with final preference selections closing Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> August.
