Other information

- All students undertaking the HSC must first complete the HSC: All My Own Work program.
- All students must complete Minimum Standards in reading, writing and numeracy.
- For most Board Developed Courses, school-based assessment throughout the HSC course contributes 50% of the HSC mark.
- You may accumulate HSC courses towards the Higher School Certificate over a period of up to five years. Preliminary courses may also be accumulated.
